

# APSB Pony of the Year

This concept has been developed to encourage competitors to support their regional and breed promotional group shows as well as local agricultural shows. Once again, we are aiming to have a Junior, Senior and Saddle class in the following sections:- Australian, Connemara, Dartmoor, Fjord, Gypsy Cob, Hackney, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh, Part Bred, and APSB Riding Pony. For the Hackney, the saddle section will be replaced by harness which will be judged during the harness classes earlier in the day.

This breed showcase will be held on the Saturday afternoon/evening at the 2012 Stud Show, allowing for those not competing a chance to watch and catch up with friends before enjoying their Dinner and the entertainment provided.

## Qualifying Shows

Qualifying shows are any Group, Agricultural or Breed Show that has APSB classes. It was found that it was very difficult for some members in some areas of the state to attend qualifying shows.

To be eligible to enter the Pony of the Year all you have to do is complete the entry form and send in with your Stud Show entries.

## Rules

- Any Promotional Group APSB Breed class is eligible along with any APSB class at Breed or Agricultural Shows.
- Ponies must place (first, second or third) in their particular breed class at one of these shows to be eligible to enter into their appropriate class at the final.
- Only one placing at a promotional group show is required for entry.
- Ponies must enter to be eligible to compete in the final. The final will be held at the APSB Victorian Stud Show 2012.
- Junior ponies are those 3 years and under
- Senior ponies are 4 years and over
- Saddle ponies must be at least 3 years of age to compete in the saddle section.
