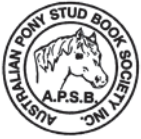

Presidents Report

Hi All,

We have had a busy time over the past months, with moves to stop fire branding and Animal welfare issues we have a challenging time.

The Australian Pony Stud Book Society has sent letters to the Minister for Agriculture the Hon Peter Walsh MP.

Comment from APSB Inc. on the draft of THE AUSTRALIAN HORSE WELFARE PROTOCOL. To express in principle, support for the draft of the Australian horse welfare protocol. This supports our own code for the Welfare of our ponies.

The issue of proposed Changes to the Draft code of Practice the clause regarding branding of horses.

The APSB Inc. supports fire branding as the most acceptable form of identification at this time, these reasons have been clearly stated to the Minister. Whilst we support the continuance of fire branding... we would also support any requirements within section 16 of this draft of the AHWP that would require breed Societies and Associations to adopt an education program for their members on branding procedures.

At this time we have had no word back about these possible changes or when or if they will be implemented.

We have also updated our extreme weather policy, we will advise on website, newsletters, forums, programs and phone office recording.

And will have updated for the practises of Biosecurity for Events and Venue's

We are returning to Bendigo for our 2012 Stud Show.

I hope members have seen our 80th year commemorative badge and plaque and many of them have been presented at our Shows, they also will be available for purchase.

We are all looking forward to our new foals arriving and another show season around the corner, safe and happy foaling, and enjoy your ponies.

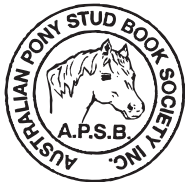

JOINT PATRONS APSB VICTORIAN BRANCH MERV PEARSON & ALEX MORGAN

Both Merv and Alex were part of a very successful and progressive Victorian Branch Committee in the late 1960s through to the early 90s.

They were part of a team during this period that included members such as Bob Owen, Heather Ronald, Reg Pedretti, Les Taylor, Colin Goldsmith, Geoff Mashiter, Alvie Ferry and Bruce Hamblin to name just some of those members of committee who *made a difference* to the progress and development of the Victorian Branch during these years.

Alex partnered with the late Reg Pedretti to successfully initiate a number of ideas that helped in the promotion of the breeds and the society – Merv worked well with everyone, always prepared to roll up his sleeves and take on whatever needed to be done and always gave considerable thought to committee matters before a decision was made – Merv had the knack of getting to the heart of the matter and often what looked like being a drawn out discussion was concluded much sooner than expected.

Along with their wives Merv and Alex were part of the 'Social Committee' formed in 1971 and the first of the Victorian Branch promotional groups. Alex held the position of Vice President of the Victorian Branch in 1971, both were elected as Delegates to Federal Council in 1972 with Alex taking the position of Victorian Branch President in 1973 for a two year term.

Merv was elected as Vice President in 1974, he joined Alex as one of the Vice Presidents in '75 before taking on the role of President in 1979. Both represented the Victorian Branch as Delegates to Federal Council on numerous occasions. Merv also held the position of Branch Treasurer.

Alex was nominated for Life Membership in 1976 and Merv in 1984 for their valued contribution to the APSB Society and members. In their time on Committee both earned the respect of their peers for their dedication to the Society and are worthy recipients of the role of Joint Patron to the Victorian Branch.

APSB Shetland Pony Foal Futurity

Small Shetland 8.2hh & under Promotional Group Entry Conditions



The APSB Foal Futurity run by the Shetland Pony 8.2hh & under Promotional Group is a competition for 2 year old ponies. Prize money is on offer with first to fifth place receiving a percentage of the entry fees for their section.

Rules

- You must enter the foal before it is born.
- Entries close on July 31 each year so if you have covered your mare this season you may enter her unborn foal.
HOWEVER – for the 2011 season only to get the futurity underway, entries will be accepted for first nominations up to 30 October, 2011.
- You must then re-enter the pony as a yearling and again when it is a 2 year old.
- The final of the competition will be judged at the annual show held by the Small Shetland Pony Promotional Group in late April/early May.
- There are TWO sections – a section for Shetland ponies to mature 8.2hh and under (and must be under 8.2hh at the 2yo competition); and a section for Shetland ponies to mature 8.2hh-10.2hh.
- The 2nd and 3rd nominations and payments can be made at the same time, meaning you only need to sit down and do the paperwork once after the initial nomination if you wish. You can still choose to submit a nomination each year, it's your choice.
- 2 Year old Maturity for the 2012 & 2013 years only

All nominations must be in the hands of the Foal Futurity Co-ordinator no later than July 31 each year, except for the 2011 initial nominations which must be received by 30 September.

Section 1: Shetland Ponies eligible in this section will be **born after 1 August 2011** and are therefore currently unborn.
Fee: \$2.00

Section 2: Shetland Ponies eligible in this section will be rising 1yo and must have been nominated as an unborn foal.
Fee: \$5.00

Section 3: Shetland Ponies eligible in this section will be rising 2yo and must have been nominated as an unborn foal and followed up with a yearling nomination the previous year.
Fee: \$8.00

Section 4: Shetland Ponies eligible for the 2012 & 2013 years classes, are to be rising 2years to enter 2 year old maturity.
\$8.00 These need to be entered on this form and entries in by the 30/9/2011 for the first year and 31st/7/2012 for the next year.

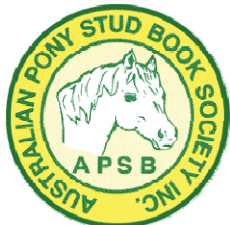
