APSB Vic 2011 Gypsy Cob of The Year

Jango Dancer is a superlative Blagdon Gypsy Cob stallion imported from the world renowned Brackenhill Stables (UK) owned by Gypsy Breeder and Artist James Taylor. James is a born and bred Gypsy whose entire life revolves around the breeding of these unique and magical horses.

Jango was the fourth Gypsy Stallion to come to Australia and one of the first eight horses to enter the country. He arrived on Australian shores in the latter part of 2006.

Jango is an exceptional example of the Gypsy Cob breed and comes from deep within the UK Gypsy Community. Jango has some of the most sought after bloodlines in the world including the Frainy lines (stemming from the legendary Sid's Good Stallion, aka The Frainy Horse), The Dock Tailed Horse and The Lob.

Jango is a lovely stallion with a high play drive and a great deal of cocky confidence. Very little phases him. True to his breed he adores being with people and loves to be involved with anything going on.

Jango Dancer made history in early 2011 becoming the first ever Gypsy Cob to take out the APSB (Vic) Stud Show's "Pony of The Year – Gypsy Cob".
